#### **The Solution**

Conversion of a late 1980's spec built single storey, stand alone office building situated within a landscaped business park, into a modern, fully serviced sample testing / research & development facility.

Redesign and reconstruction of the 900m2 floor space to provide 3 no new R&D laboratories, associated support labs, calibration areas, offices, storage areas and new, multi media conference facility. The laboratories incorporate 10 no fume cupboards and fully serviced laboratory benching. New M&E plant serving the laboratories included new AHU and fume cupboard extract systems located within a new external compound area.

The new compound, constructed of matching facing brick work and timber boarded fencing also contains a centralised chemical, solvent and gas storage area, as well as provision for secure on-site parking.

Close team working with the Client and user groups created a positive approach to the design and construction phases which allowed time on site to be kept to a minimum, and on-going changes to user requirements to be accommodated throughout the duration of the project.
